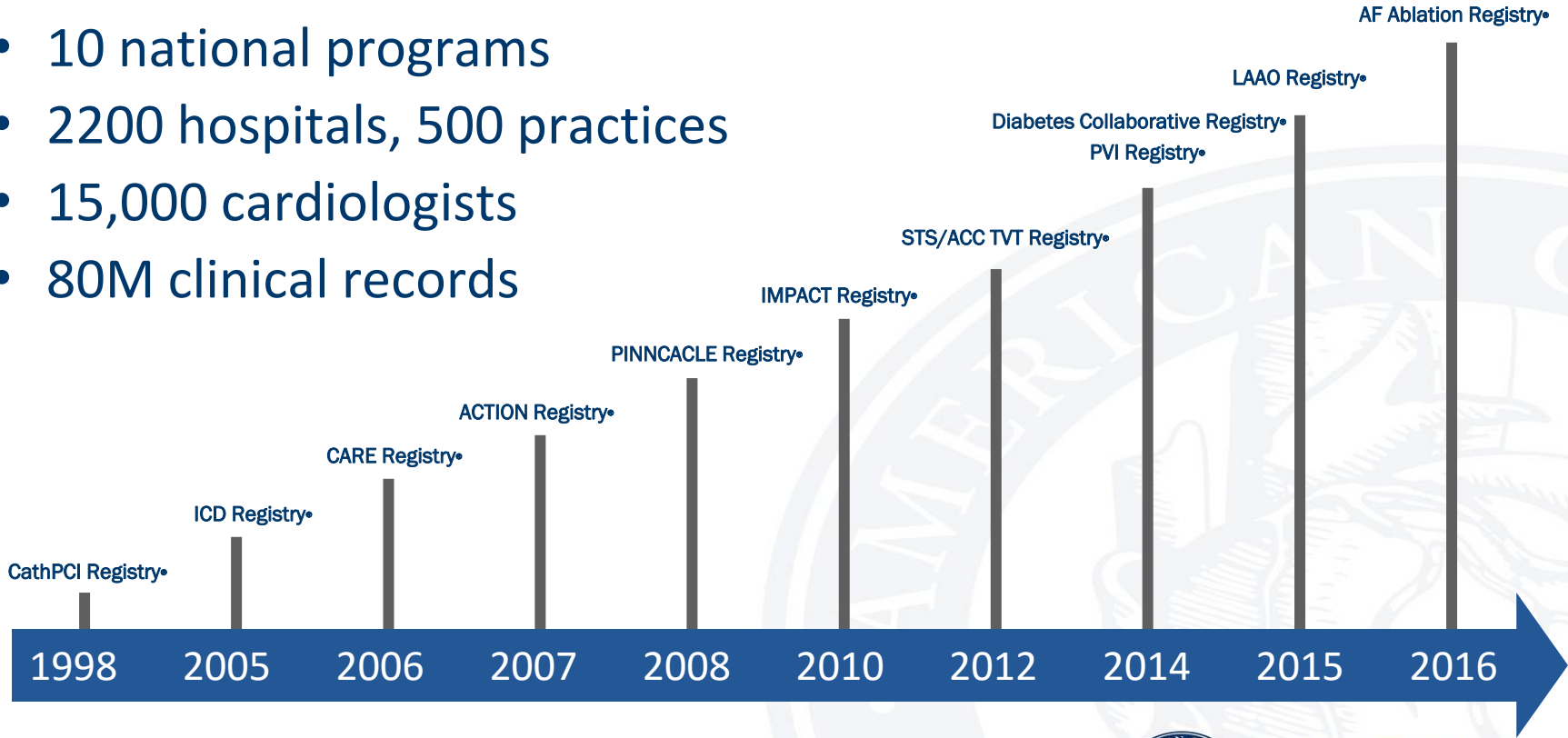

# NCDR PVI Registry™



- Registry version upgrade underway
- All 100 recommended RAPID core data elements have been added as part of the upgrade
- Anticipated launch Q3 2018

# NCDR PVI Registry™

- Registry expansion will include new modules to meet the identified needs from our participants and clinicians
  - Endo and open AAA, Open lower extremity bypass, venous and renal/mesenteric
- Data elements will be mapped to the newly published PVI AUC (Appropriate Use Criteria)
- Supplemental form
- Availability of the portfolio of NCDR resources

# NCDR PVI Registry™

- Substantial interest in the RAPID Phase II/III Research Project- **SPEED**
- Need in-depth information followed by our internal review of scientific endeavor, Registry scope of work, funding mechanisms, and creation of business model
- Feasibility after launch of PVI Version upgrade Q3 2018





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
